


Teleos Preparatory Academy Annual Academic Data Report

Teleos Preparatory Academy, despite being only in its third year of operation, is developing a strong track record of academic success. The 2011 AIMS results in mathematics, reading, writing, and science indicate that Teleos Prep has higher scores than any school in the Roosevelt School District and is ranked as one of the top schools in all of Laveen, South Phoenix, and Central Phoenix. As the included graphs indicate, the AIMS passing rates of Teleos students continue to grow. In addition,

though Teleos Prep's overall AIMS passing rate is below the average at the other Great Hearts schools, Teleos' growth rates continue to climb and are toward the top when compared to the other Great Hearts schools. Student growth is now a key determinant utilized by the Arizona Department of Education in assigning school labels and this accomplishment is a strong reason why Teleos Prep has now been promoted from a Performing to a Performing Plus school.




Despite this success, we at Teleos Prep recognize that we must continue to improve in order to reach our Big Goal of meeting and exceeding the AIMS results of our sister schools at Great Hearts Academies. As we work toward this Big Goal, we have set the following incremental goals for the 2011-2012 school year:

- Teleos Prep will exceed the state average on both the mathematics and reading portions of the AIMS test.
- 2. Teleos Prep will receive a "Highly Performing" school label.

In order to achieve these goals, we have initiated the following school-wide programs and endeavors this year:

- 1. **Increased Instructional Support** We have increased the amount of training, observation, and support our teachers receive in and outside of the classroom.
- 2. **New Curriculum** We have purchased a new mathematics curriculum for 6^{th} - 8^{th} grade which more closely aligns to the common core and Arizona state standards.
- 3. "Buckle Down" AIMS preparation program We have incorporated an hour of additional instruction and practice in mathematics, reading, and writing before school 3 days a week.
- 4. **Strategic Student Grouping** We have utilized data from our first round of Acuity predictive testing and Reading A-Z diagnostics to group students by performance level in mathematics and reading in order to provide targeting instruction at each level.



Through these efforts and the complete devotion of our incredible faculty and staff, we are confident that Teleos Preparatory Academy will continue to excel and meet its goals. We look forward to sharing our students' strong results with you again in next year's School Performance Update.
